- **Connected Farm Irrigate app** – control pivot irrigation systems along with real-time monitoring of pivot status

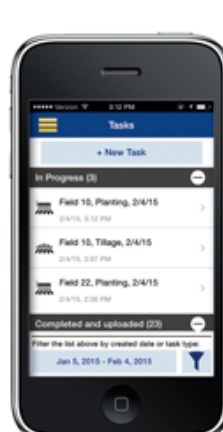

Simplify Field Record Keeping

Enter detailed field records using your smartphone or tablet. Install to multiple devices so that records can be collected instantly and sent to Connected Farm Field where profit/loss information can be viewed for the entire operation.

- Enter details about each field operation (tillage, planting, spraying, harvest, etc.).
- Select your field conditions and auto detect your weather information for chemical reporting.
- View all previously entered field records from your device or from other devices.

A new feature is now available for viewing profit and loss for each field and crop season. As you upload data from supported precision ag displays or from the new Connected Farm Field app, summary information tied to costs allow you to see what areas of the farm are most profitable and why.

- Use the easy-to-understand graphs and charts to see a quick summary of farm profitability
- Enter costs for inputs and values for your harvested crop
- Analyze details for each field including time and area covered, operators, machinery, materials used, weather, field conditions, and other notes

Farm Works™ version 2015.03 includes a new reporting feature that uses the 21 financial measures (also known as ratios) that the Farm Financial Standards Council has outlined in their document "Financial Guidelines for Agriculture". This report is interactive and allows you to click on any ratio to see how it is computed in order to learn how the values are calculated. Ratios can be printed for one to five years and can help you understand trends of what is and what is not working on your farm.
